Nehemiah Project 21 Daily Devotions

DEVOTION #8 - Sunday, October 16

My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me; and I give eternal life to them, and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of My hand. JOHN 10:27-28, NASB

God wants to speak to you. Have you ever thought about that? Hearing God isn't a privilege reserved just for pastors, religious leaders, or "spiritual people." The Bible teaches us that God speaks to every Christian. So, if you're a Christ-follower, that includes you.

In John 10:27-28, Jesus assures us that He speaks to every one of His followers. That means every Christian has the ability to hear God's voice. If someone says, "God never talks to me," it just means they probably don't know how to hear God speak. If that's you, if you've never heard God's voice before, that can change. It all begins with a real relationship with God. Stop for a moment and say this prayer out loud right now:
